What Is Open Care?

Qualifying school districts now have the flexibility to bill Medicaid for health services delivered to all Medicaid-enrolled students, and not just those with an IEP.

Who Is Eligible?

Students with a care plan that receive medically-necessary services.

Care plans that are prescribed and signed/dated by a Qualified Medical Provider (QMP) enrolled with Medicaid.

Care plans that contain the scope, duration and frequency of services needed.

Examples of School District Health Plans That Could Qualify if Compliance Guidelines Are Met (Not All Inclusive):

- IHCP-Individual Health Care Plan
- IFSP-Individualized Family Service Plan
- Section 504 Plan
- Chronic Illness Plan
- Chronic Health Plan
- Behavior
- Safety
- MTSS
- Or are otherwise medically necessary
